1. CONTENTS OF THE SERVICE

- **Paterson's Licensing acts:**

This dataset contains all the relevant statutes and statutory instruments relating to liquor licensing, betting and gaming with annotations and commentary. Each month the contents of Paterson's will be updated as required with the updates highlighted in red text so that you are quickly alerted to any changes in the law.

- **Cases:**

The cases dataset is divided into three parts:

All ER Licensing cases: Contains liquor licensing, betting and gaming cases sourced from the *All England Law Reports*.

Brewing Trade Reports: The Brewers and Licensed Retailers Association have kindly permitted Butterworths to reproduce in full, all the brewing trade reports cited in *Paterson's* for your ease of reference.

Unreported Cases: Contains unreported transcripts dating back to 1997. More transcripts with commentary will be added on a regular basis. Users are invited to submit any judgments relating to liquor and entertainment licensing which they consider to be of interest to Juliet Atkins of Butterworths.

- **Current Issues:**

This section will keep users informed of proposals for legislative reform in liquor licensing, betting and gaming. For the launch, we have included an extract on the issue of regulating gambling on the internet, written by Kevin de Haan QC, from the long-awaited new edition of *Smith and Monckom: Law of Betting, Gaming and Lotteries*.

- **News and Current Awareness:**

A weekly news update on liquor licensing, betting and gaming related material.

- **Email Alerter:**

This service enables the user to receive notification via email of any new current awareness items that have been added to the site. You can select the frequency with which you would like to receive these alerters, and on which subject area, by left clicking once on the radio button beside your choice.

- **Search News Archive:**

This search tool automatically searches the news archive by word or phrase. You can search through all fields, or refine your search to the fields of article title, summary, source or publication date.

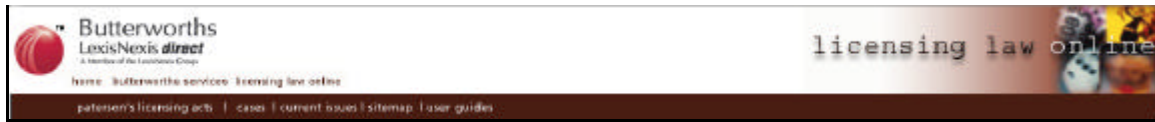

3. UNIQUE FEATURES

3.1 NAVIGATION BAR



Once you have accessed Licensing Law online you will see the navigation bar at the top of the screen, shown above. In order to access a service within Licensing Law Online, left click once on the relevant heading.

Left Clicking once 'Home' from the Navigation Bar will link to the butterworths.com Home Page. Left Clicking once 'Licensing Law Online' will return to the Licensing Law Online front page.

3.2 BOOKS ON SCREEN [BOS]

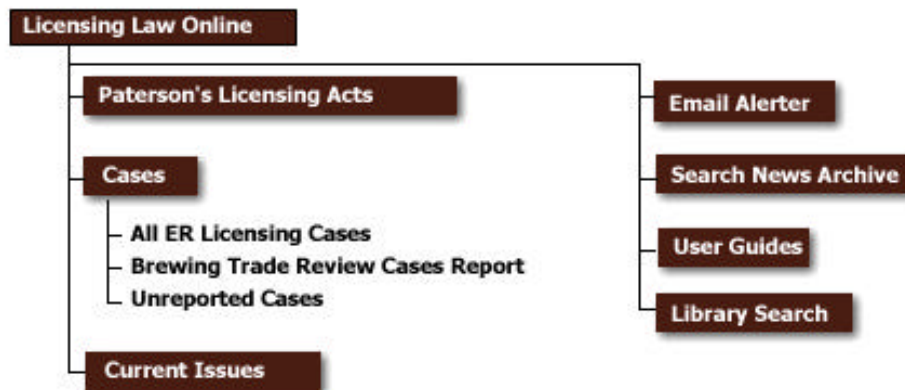
"Pensions Law Reference", "Legislation", "Cases" and "Form Filler" all use books on screen software.
